At the top of the Acropolis, we explore The Parthenon, temple to the Greek goddess Athena, along with the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike and the sacred temple of Erechtheion. You'll also view the Dionysus Theater at the base of the Acropolis. Grab some lunch before enjoying free time in the afternoon. Tonight, celebrate with a festive Greek dinner show with wine and song.


## Day 3 Wed, 27-Sep-2023 Cape Sunio, Temple of Poseidon Brown Acropol, Athens (1) (B,D)

Take some free time this morning to shop and explore some of the many sites that are nearby to our centrally located hotel. After lunch, we board the our coach for an excursion to Cape Sounio for a guided tour of the Temple of Poseidon. Take in the the breathtaking views of the Mediterranean from the temple dedicated to the Greek god of the seas. We'll also view the ruins of another Greek temple to the goddess Athena. Enjoy a seafood dinner at a coastal seaside tavern before returning back to our hotel in Athens.

## Day 4 <br> Thu, 28-Sep-2023 Flight from Athens to Crete

Hersonissos Maris, Heraklion
(B,D)
This morning, we leave our Athens hotel and transfer to the airport for a flight to the Greek island of Crete. Crete is the largest island in Greece, and the fifth largest island in the Mediterranean Sea, after Sicily, Sardinia, Cyprus and Corsica. The short flight brings us into Crete early enough to check into our seaside resort hotel in Heriklion. There is plenty of free time to aquaint ourselves with the local surroundings or relax on the beach or by the pool. Tonight's included dinner is at the hotel.

## Day 5 Fri, 29-Sep-2023 Heraklion, Knossos and Minoan Palace Hersonissos Maris, Heraklion (B,D)

Today we visit to the Minoan Palace at Knossos. The initial construction of the palace dates back to about 2000 B.C. which makes it the oldest active Bronze Age archeological site. However, it has been estimated that Neolithic inhabitants settled the region as far back as 7,000 B.C. Because of this, Knossos has been (unofficially) called Europe's oldest city. Lunch is included today. Dinner tonight is back in the hotel and, as always, will be served with a glass of wine.

Hersonissos Maris, Heraklion ( $B, D$ )

After a long history of warfare, the fort was turned into one of the last leper colonies in the early 20th century. Uninhabited today, it has become a popular destination for tourists and historians alike. It is currently being considered by UNESCO for World Heritage Site status. Dinner tonight is served in the hotel.
